REGISTRATION PROCEDURES 2009/2010 SEASON

The registration procedure is as follows:

NEW CHERUBS (As yet to receive an official registration number)

In order to receive a number for a new Cherub the boat will firstly need to be measured by the Technical Officer (currently Wayne Torpy). On completion of a successful measurement and the payment of the **\$20.00 measurement fee** the owner shall be issued with a signed measurement certificate. It is then the owner's responsibility to contact the State Secretary (currently Ewan Duckworth) and provide him with the original certificate. The owners should keep a copy of this certificate for their own records. On receipt of the original measurement certificate, the Secretary will obtain a number for the boat from the National Registrar (currently Ken Ewings). It is emphasised to members that a number will not be issued unless the secretary has received the completed original measurement form.

The owner should contact the secretary at a later date to receive their allocated number. The number allotted will be the next available consecutive number held by the Australian National Council. It is expected the process of receiving a number from the national registrar will take at least 3 days.

On receipt of a number, the owner should then follow the procedure for boats registering for the 2009/2010 season.

CHERUBS REGISTERING FOR THE 2009/2010 SEASON:

Owners of boats registering for the 2009/2010 season will need to fill out a Boat Registration 2009/2010 form and return this to the State Secretary by 1st November 2009.
