

1967 1968 Australian National Cherub Championships

Beauty Point, Tasmania

The Australian Cherub class championships were held at Beauty Point, on the Tamar River. The host club this year was the Port Dalrymple Yacht Club. The West Australian boat, *Ace*, sailed by Gordon Lucas, was way out in front of any competitors and won four of the five races. The race he failed to win he was forced to retire from because of a rules breach. Had he finished he probably would have taken out all the heats. Gordon Lucas who is only nineteen-year-old, managed to win both the senior and the junior championships. Second in the final placings was Ian Lindsay, NSW, who sailed his boat, *GL II* to beat the third placegetter C. Nash, also from NSW with his boat *Sequando*.
