

## 1994-1995 Australian National Cherub Championships

### **Belmont, NSW**

Belmont crew wins Cherubs John Boyd and Geoff Bauchop of Belmont 16ft SC won the Australian Cherub championship on home waters Belmont Bay, Lake Macquarie. Boyd and Bauchop, who also sail together on the 18ft skiff *KPMG Peat Marwick*, won both the first and second heats on *Genetic Misfortune* to begin the series in the best possible way, followed by a win and another second.

Georges River Sailing Club crew, Jamie Roberts and Jason Jordan on *Smashing Pumpkins* finished the series strongly with two seconds followed by two wins, to finish three points behind Boyd, Bauchop.

Third was another Belmont boat, *Hooters & Moisties* (Adam Piper, Gary Boyd). A fleet of 43 contested the championship.
